

# Houston Senior Travelers League (HSTL)

## **Club Champion Playoffs & Travelers Trophy**

(Revised November 13, 2023)

**Overview:** The Club Championship special event is designed to be a test of consistency played over 4 rounds. There are two categories of winners:

Net Winner and Club Champion:	total-low-net score over 4 rounds, and
Gross Score Champion:	total-low-gross score over 4 rounds.

**Cost:** There are no additional costs to participate.

**Scheduling:** The four rounds overlap with the last 4 rounds of the season.

**Qualification:** Only members who have played a minimum of 25 regular season tournaments as of the date of the first round of the Club Championship are eligible to compete to be Club Champion and Gross Score Champion. In the event there are more than 120 qualifiers, the top 120 point leaders who enter the first round will qualify.

**Entry:** All players must request entry via standard email signup. Each day will be limited to 120 players. Members who have played 25 regular tournaments and are in the top 120 point leaders as of the date of the first round of the Club Championship have priority entry until the Second Call for the tournament date. At that time, other members who have requested entry will be entered based upon their email entry time (first-come, first-served), but will not be eligible to compete to be Club Champion.

In the event the League plays less than a full schedule in any year, the Board may reduce the 25-regular tournament minimum.

**Seeding:** Regular weekly pairings will be used for the first two events. See “Seeding” within the 2-day Year-End Event for details on seeding for the last two events.

**Format:** This is a 4-Day, Total- Stroke, Event. For the Club Championship event, it is a Total-Low-Net-Stroke Event. For the Gross-Score Championship, it is a Total-Low-Gross-Stroke Event.

**Payouts – Money and Points:** The Club Champion will receive a payout of \$300 plus 30 additional Travelers points. In addition, his or her name will be engraved on the Travelers Trophy on display in the WindRose club house. The Gross Score Champion will receive a payout of \$200 plus 20 additional Travelers points. In the event the same golfer wins low net and low gross titles, the winner will only receive the Club Champion payout. The golfer with the next total-low-net score will receive \$200 and 20 points.

**Rules / Tiebreaker:** All HSTL rules apply. The HSTL standard scorecard tiebreak procedure will be applied using all 4 rounds of the Club Championship to determine winners of any tie.
